## ADVANCED DIVER

The Advanced Diver program provides divers with the opportunity to gain additional diving experience, update diving skills and become safer, more competent divers. Advanced divers develop the confidence and problem solving skills to plan, lead and more thoroughly enjoy their dives. The program is designed to be:

- **FUN with hands on learning**
- **CONVENIENT**
- **PRACTICAL**

## REQUIREMENTS

To become certified as an Advanced Diver, you must:

- Be at least 12 years old
- Be certified as a Open Water Diver, Junior Open Water Diver or equivalent
- Have logged at least 24 dives.

## TRAINING

The Advanced Diver program consists of 4 specialty courses, including at least 6 open water dives. You can choose from 2 available paths to reach the Advanced Diver certification:

- **Option A:** Advanced Program
- **Option B:** Specialty and Experience Program

**Specialty training is also available on HPSC-sponsored trips to Bonaire, Cozumel, the Cayman Islands, and more. Contact us for details.**



## OPTION A: Advanced Program

The HPSC Advanced Diver program is a prepackaged offering that enables you to complete the program in minimal time (usually one weekend for the specialty dives). HPSC has selected a core offering of five specialties:

- Night/Limited Visibility
- Deep
- Navigation
- High Altitude
- Computer



From these specialties, four will be taught during the program. (The fourth specialty will be either computer or altitude, which do not require a text.) The selection of specialties will depend upon the open water conditions being used for the program.

**FEE: \$325.00 Local**

**\$430.00 Blue Hole** (includes 2 nights lodging  
Based on double occupancy)

**ADD: \$100.00 Private Upgrade** (For 1 on 1 training)

Option A includes:

- Academic Session and 6 Training Dives
- Scuba unit & Wetsuit as Appropriate
- Advanced Text Kit
- Advanced Certification Card

## OPTION B: Specialty Experience Program

With this option, you set the pace of the training. The number of specialties and dives remains the same as Option A, but you select the schedule and specialties that meet your needs.

You can complete the specialties individually on your own in a home study program, over a period of time. For example, you can earn your night/limited visibility diving specialty by doing a home study course with the textbook and video, completing the study guide, taking the final exam, and doing 2 verified night dives. The fourth specialty may be either computer or altitude, which do not require a text.

When you have completed the 4 specialties and total of 24 dives, simply come into HPSC and we will review your material and issue your certification card.

**FEE: \$150.00** Includes the four academic review sessions, course exams, and your Advanced Certification card.

**(Some restrictions may apply.)**

## WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

Your course fee does **not** include:

- Text Materials
- Transportation
- Meals
- Equipment for specific specialty courses, such as primary light, chemical or marker light for night/limited visibility dives, compass for navigation dives and altitude table for altitude diving.

## AFTER GRADUATION

Complete the Stress & Rescue Diver program, have 50 logged dives and receive your MASTER DIVER rating.
