DIVER PROGRESSION PROGRAM

When you have completed your Open Water Certification course but feel as though you might need a bit more experience and training before you head to the ocean **OR** you want to progress onto higher levels of training then the Diver Progression Program is for you. This program is designed to help each scuba diver move forward in their experience and training to unlock greater fun and potential opportunities awaiting them now and in the future.

To join the Diver Progression Program you must:

REQUIREMENTS

- Be at least 12 years old
- Be certified as a Open Water Diver, Junior Open Water Diver or equivalent

To complete the Diver Progression Program you must:

- Log at least 12 dives to *complete* your Specialty Diver Certification (You may start at any time)

The Diver Progression Program consists of 4 specialty

TRAINING

courses, including at least 6 open water dives. You can choose from 3 available paths to reach the Specialty Diver certification:

- Option A: Diver Progression Program
- Option B: Diver Progression Plus Program
- Option C: Specialty and Experience Program



OPTION A: Diver Progression Program

The Diver Progression Program helps new divers reach Specialty Diver rating by providing training for 4 specialty courses while acquiring dives to reach your experience goals. The specialties offered are:

- Night/Limited Visibility
- Deep
- Navigation
- High Altitude or Computer

This set of skills may be customized for travel programs or with pre-approval of your dive instructor.

FEE: \$325.00 (includes Specialty text kit)
\$430.00 Blue Hole (includes 2 nights lodging Based on double occupancy)

ADD: \$100.00 Private Upgrade (For 1 on 1 training)

Option A includes:

- Academic and Open Water Training
- Use of scuba unit & 7mm wetsuit

OPTION B: Diver Progression+ Program

The Diver Progression Plus Program includes everything listed in Option A: Diver Progression Program plus two additional dive-along weekends to the Blue Hole, NM. When you have completed at least 24 dives we will also issue you your Advanced Certification.

FEE: \$705.00 (includes Specialty text kit)

Option B includes:

- Academic and Open Water Training
- Use of scuba unit & 7mm wetsuit
- Lodging: 2 nights at Blue Hole, NM (Dbl. Occ.)
- Plus 2 additional weekend Dive-Along Packages to the Blue Hole, NM to accrue more dives.

OPTION C: Specialty and Experience Program

With this option, you set the pace of the training. The number of specialties and dive requirements remains the same as Option A & B, but you select the schedule and specialties that meet your needs.

You can complete the specialties individually on your own in a home study program, over a period of time. For example, you can earn your night/limited visibility diving specialty by doing a home study course with the textbook and video, completing the study guide, taking the final exam, and doing 2 verified night dives..

When you have completed the 4 specialties and total of 12 dives, simply come into HPSC and we will review your material and issue your Specialty Diver certification card. After you complete a total of 24 dives, simply come back to HPSC and we will again review your material and then issue your Advanced Certification card.

FEE: \$150.00 Includes the four academic review sessions, course exams, Specialty Diver card and your Advanced Certification card.

(Home study course materials are not included)

(Some restrictions may apply.)

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

Your course fee does **not** include:

- Transportation
- Meals
- Equipment for specific specialty courses, such as primary light, tank marker light, compass and high altitude table.
